
HIKING & OTHER ADVENTURES NEAR BONCLARKEN



HOOKER FALLS TRAILHEAD— **DUPONT STATE FOREST (15 MI)**

The Hooker Falls trailhead provides access to Triple Falls and Hooker Falls. The Triple Falls trail offers a moderate hike and photo opportunities. The Hooker Falls trail offers an easy hike on a relatively flat gravel path.

← From the Bonclarken front gate, turn left onto NC-225 S 0.4 mi.

Turn right onto Little River Rd. @ stoplight 4.1 mi.

Turn left onto Crab Creek Rd.

7.1 mi.

Turn left onto Dupont Rd

1 Continue straight—Dupont Rd. becomes Staton Rd.

Turn right @ Hooker Falls parking lot sign

1.9 mi.

HIGH FALLS TRAILHEAD & **DUPONT SF VISITORS CENTER (16 MI)**

The Dupont SF Visitors Center offers information about recreational opportunities in Dupont and features knowledgeable staff and a diorama of the park. From the High Falls trailhead you can hike to High Falls and the covered bridge, Bridal Veil Falls, Grassy Creek Falls, and Lake Julia.

← From the Bonclarken front gate, turn left onto NC-225 S 0.4 mi.

Turn right onto Little River Rd. @ stoplight

4.1 mi.

Turn left onto Crab Creek Rd. 7.1 mi.

Turn left onto Dupont Rd

1.2 mi.

Î Continue straight—Dupont Rd. becomes Staton Rd.

Turn left @ High Falls parking lot sign

CARL SANDBURG NHS (1 MI)

Carl Sandburg NHS features the home of the popular American poet, a working goat farm, and hiking trails. Just a short distance from Bonclarken, it is an ideal short trip for children and adults.

From the Bonclarken front gate, turn left onto NC-225 S 0.4 mi.

Turn right onto Little River Rd. @ stoplight

Turn left @ Carl Sandburg NHS sign

SKY TOP ORCHARD (4 MI)

There are many great apple orchards in the area. Sky Top is located closest to Bonclarken and is a popular you-pick orchards. Their on-site store offers apples, cider, baked goods, and apple cider doughnuts.

← From the Bonclarken front gate, turn left onto NC-225 S 2.5 mi.

Turn right onto Pinnacle Mountain Rd.

1.1 mi.

Follow Pinnacle Mountain Rd. to Sky Top Orchard

HOLMES EDUCATIONAL FOREST (10 MI)

The Holmes Educational Forest offers exhibits about managed forestry and mountain ecology. Children will also enjoy the Forest Service firefighting displays including a fire plow, replica firetower, and Huey helicopter.

← From the Bonclarken front gate, turn left onto NC-225 S

Turn right onto Little River Rd. @ stoplight

4.1 mi.

Turn left onto Crab Creek Rd.

Turn left @ Holmes Educational State Forest sign
